Kamakura (Snow Hut)



Yokote in Akita Prefecture is located in northern Japan and is a heavy snowfall area. Kamakura (snow hut) Festival is a traditional lunar calendar event that is held every year on February 15 and 16. Kamakura is with a history of around 450 years and is famous as a leading winter festival of Tohoku. An altar is built in each kamakura and worships the God of Water. 30 tons of snow is necessary to make one kamakura. It is with a diameter of approximately 4 meters and a height of 3 meters. Inside kamakura, children entertain the visitors by offering toasted Mochi (rice cake) and Amazake (a sweet drink made from fermented rice).



Bonden



A "Bonden" refers to a big object in shape of gohei (a wand with plaited paper streamers in Shinto) where divine spirits are drawn. Bonden are imbued with various prayers (e.g. for a bumper crop, peace and prosperity in the household or a thriving business) and then dedicated to the AsahiOkayama Shrine every year on February 17. The bon-den of Yokote are characterized by their unprecedented size, elegance and gorgeousness. The length of their poles are about 4.3 m. A cylindrical bamboo basket with a diameter of about 90 cm is attached to the head of the pole and colorful "sagari" (fabrics and hemp yarns), shimenawa (ropes used to cordon off consecrated areas), shide (paper streamers) and headbands are attached to it. Furthermore, ornaments designed with the Chinese zodiac, dolls or something similar are placed on the top of the pole. The overall size of a bon-den well exceeds 5 m and it weighs more than 30 kg.

From Narita:
 From Narita airport, take the shuttle to Haneda Airport (approx. 85 mins.). Then from Haneda, fly to Akita Airport (approx. 60 mins.). From Akita Airport, shuttles are available to take you to Yokote (approx. 75 mins.).

 From Tokyo Station, take the Akita Shinkansen "Komachi" to Omagari (approx. 3 hrs.). Then from Omagari, take a local train to Yokote (approx. 20 mins.).
